# PARK SAFETY, RULES & MORE:

# WE LOOK FORWARD TO HAVING YOU VISIT US & WE'RE CONFIDENT YOU'LL HAVE A GREAT TIME!

### AND PLEASE..... BE COURTEOUS TO OTHER PARK VISITORS.

(Help keep the park a safe and fun place for all age groups!)

## **GO-KARTS:**

#### **OPERATE KART IN A SAFE AND RESPONSIBLE MANNER.**

Pay attention, listen to, and follow "Pit-Crew" instructions at all times!!!

#### WARNING: Failure to comply with track regulations will result in ticket revocation!

(Respect track rules and regulations.)

- Certain health considerations should be taken into effect before deciding to ride a go-kart. If you have an injury or have any other health related issues check with your doctor first. (If you are pregnant you should not ride go-karts!)
- Before the ride begins, if you have any questions or concerns, raise your hand. (Our "Pit-Crew" will provide you with any assistance you may need.)
- You don't need a license to drive a go-kart, unless you are taking a passenger.
- If you're taking a passenger, you must have a valid drivers license. (Kids can't drive with other kids.)
- Drivers must be 54 inches tall. ~ If you're under 54 inches, you're not tall enough to hit the brakes! (So please don't ask.) All kart operations are governed by the State of NH department of safety.
- Passenger must be 36 inches to 54 inches tall. ~ The passenger seat is designed for children. A child (36 to 54 inches tall) can not drive. See rule above.
- Safety belts must be worn by all participants. Tip: Tighten your waist strap before tightening the shoulder straps.
- If you're taking a passenger, (under 54 inches) the passenger must get in the kart first before you can sit down. (Pit-Crew will assist in securing the safety belt for your passenger.)
- Hair longer than shoulder length must be secured & tucked into shirt. (Just ask us for an elastic band if you don't have one.)
- Running is not permitted anywhere in the park. (We don't want anyone tripping or falling!)
- No loose clothing, bags, or cameras are allowed in the go-kart. (These objects could become a safety hazards on the track's surface.)
- No bumping, weaving or reckless driving is permitted. Failure to comply will result in your cart being remotely shut down.(Your ride will end, and you will not be allowed to ride again. These are go-karts, not bumper-cars.)
- If you have a problem with your kart, remain seated with your hands in the air. ("Pit-Crew" will come over to assist you.)
- At the end of the ride, we will flag you in. Come into the pit slowly. (single file, with your left foot on the brake pedal)
- Never exit your kart & REMAIN SEATED AT END OF RIDE. (until instructed otherwise by our "pit-crew")
- If you show any signs of intoxication, or being under the influence of a controlled substances: You will not be allowed to ride go-karts. (You will also be instructed to leave.)
- Review additional safety information & requirements posted on premises.

**WARNING:** Failure to comply with track regulations will result in ticket revocation! (Respect track rules and regulations.) ~ Please be reminded that there are some young "rookie" drivers here. These "rookies", who may have never driven anything (ever before), may be driving a go-kart for the first time beside you!

#### MINIATURE-GOLF:

- Junior golfers (players under 54 inches tall) must be accompanied by adult supervision.
- Running is not permitted anywhere in the park. (We don't want anyone tripping or falling.)

#### **GENERAL NOTES:**

- OFFENSIVE BEHAVIOR IS NOT WELCOME, AND WILL BE REPORTED! (NH State Police barracks are located across the street.) ~ Their direct line (Troop-E) is
- We operate a video surveillance system that constantly captures and stores video remotely. ~ We're also told that the State Police surveillance system can actually "see" vehicles as they enter / drive by the park!No alcohol is allowed on the property.
